The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to establish clear guidelines and expectations for coaches, students, and parents participating in sports coaching sessions and Holiday Camps run by Sportitude. This policy aims to create a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment for all participants.

Responsibilities of Coaches:

- Coaches are expected to maintain a high level of professionalism at all times. This includes punctuality, appropriate dress code, and respectful communication with students, parents, and school staff.
- Coaches are responsible for ensuring the safety of all participants during coaching sessions. They should be aware of potential risks and take appropriate measures to minimiSe them.
- Coaches should provide effective instruction and guidance to enhance the skill development of all students. They should promote fair play, teamwork, and good sportsmanship.
- Coaches should treat all students with respect and fairness, regardless of their skill level, background, gender, or any other characteristic. Discrimination, bullying, or harassment will not be tolerated.
- Coaches should maintain open and transparent communication with students, parents, and school staff. They should be available to address concerns or questions in a timely manner.

Responsibilities of Students:

- Students are expected to treat coaches, teammates, opponents, and officials with respect and courtesy, follow instructions and show good sportsmanship at all times.
- Students must prioritize their own safety and the safety of others. They should adhere to safety guidelines provided by the coach.
- Students should attend coaching sessions regularly and be punctual. If unable to attend, they should notify the coach in advance.
- Students are expected to give their best effort during coaching sessions, striving for improvement and demonstrating a positive attitude.
- Students should bring appropriate sports gear and equipment as specified by the coach.

Responsibilities of Parents/Guardians:

- Parents/guardians should support their child's participation in sports coaching sessions and encourage them to abide by the Code of Conduct.
- Parents/guardians should maintain open lines of communication with coaches. They should inform coaches of any concerns or special requirements regarding their child's participation.
- Parents/guardians should respect the authority and decisions of the coach, and address any concerns in a respectful and appropriate manner.

Any violations of this Code of Conduct should be reported to Sportitude promptly. All reports will be treated confidentially, and appropriate action will be taken.
